



# Standing Conference for Equality and Diversity officers within Higher Education Institutions.

#### Who are we?

The CPED is an association regulated by the French law of 1901. It was created in January 2011 during a meeting at the University of Strasbourg. It currently has 68 members: 60 universities and 8 schools (list on the back)

The members meet every four months, for two days, in order to discuss best practices with respect to equality between men and women in our institutions. The CPED addresses the difficulties our institutions encounter in the implantation of policies to promote equality and it offers solutions to those issues.



#### **Objectives of the CPED:**

- To provide a cooperative space for the equality and diversity officers of higher education institutions in France
- To promote and facilitate equality between men and women in higher education institutions
- To observe and analyze gender policies within higher education
- To federate higher education and research institutions by encouraging shared practices with respect to gender equality

### **Current Workgroups within the CPED:**

#### - Indicators

*Objective*: to establish a list of relevant indicators in order to highlight situations of inequality between men and women in our institutions, in particular in university social audits.

#### Use of female forms in the language

*Objective*: to offer resources to promote and favor the use of both female and male forms in any written document in our institution: job profiles, call for projects, etc.

## - Selection committees

Objective: to mutualize our practices to insure parity in the job recruitment process

#### Harassment

*Objective:* to share our tools and practices to prevent harassment, sexual and sexist violence; to offer support to victims of such violence; to accompany legal and disciplinary actions

### - Follow-up on the July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013 legislation

*Objective:* to broadcast all the new legal documents and rules following the law and more precisely the texts regarding professional equality between men and women; to ensure their application within our institutions.

#### **Actions of the CPED:**

- Hearing at the National Assembly and the Senate on the Higher Education and Research law project
- 16 propositions to promote professional equality during the Higher Education and Research National Conference
- Contribution to the white paper of the National Association for Feminist studies (ANEF): "Gender in Higher Education and Research" (2014) history of equality officers and analysis of the situation in French universities.
